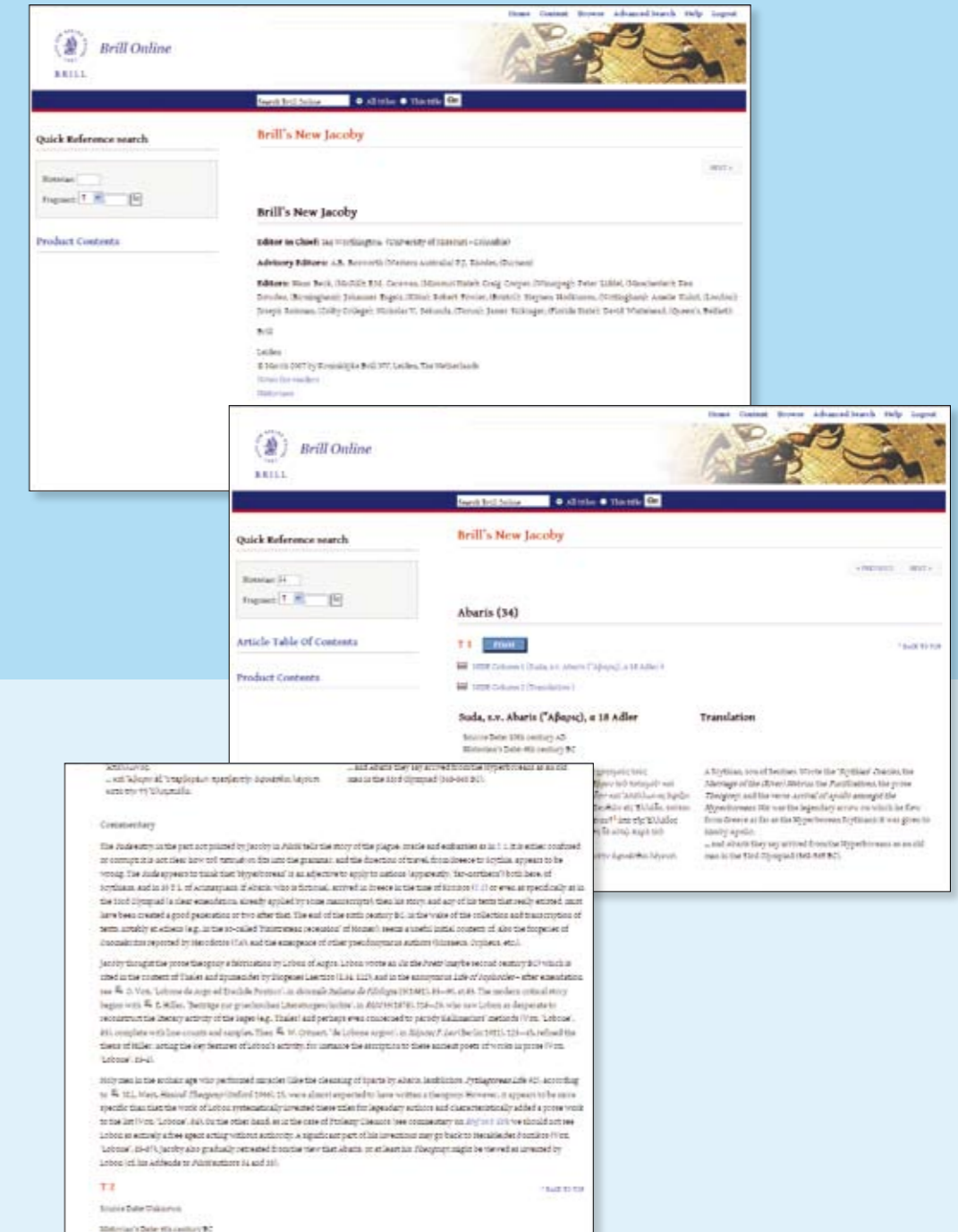

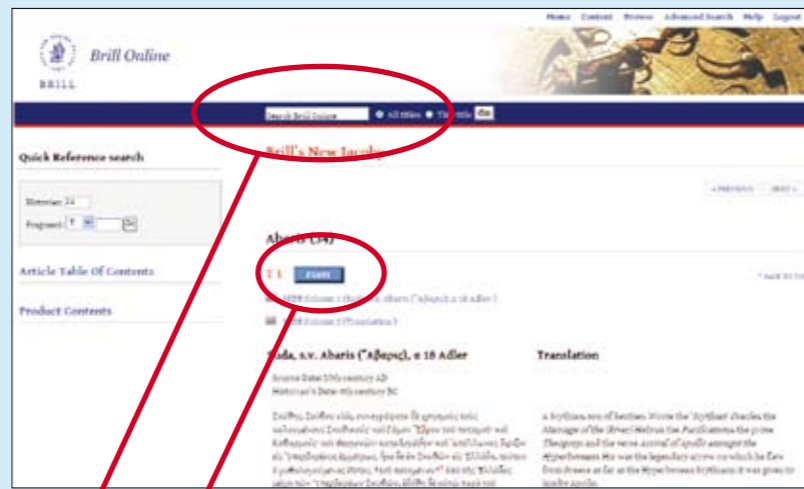

The monumental series *Die Fragmente der Griechischen Historiker, Parts I-III* by Felix Jacoby contains works by **856 Greek historians** whose writings are only preserved incompletely, i.e. in fragments. Jacoby collected these fragments (including biographical testimonies about the historians) and added a commentary, often brief, on the first 607 authors.

Brill's New Jacoby provides a revised edition of the **Greek texts** where relevant. It includes several **new authors** and many fragments of existing authors that were either unknown to Jacoby or were not included by him. It also gives commentaries by leading contemporary historians for those authors omitted by Jacoby.

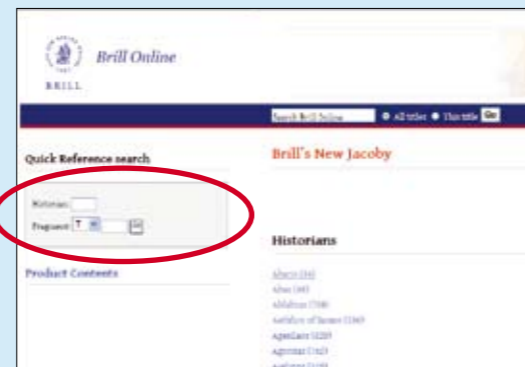

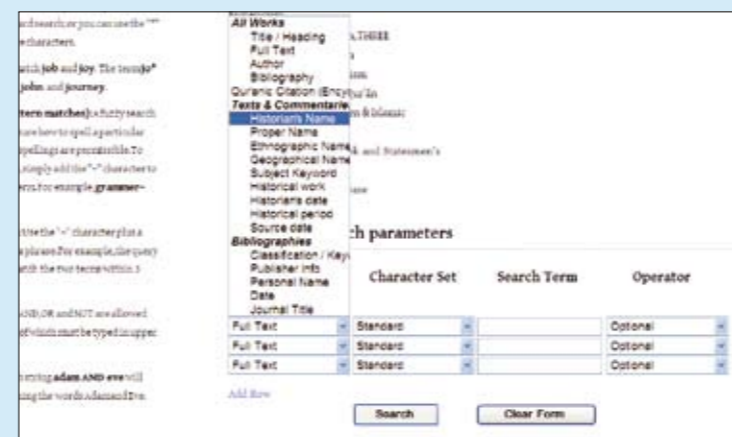

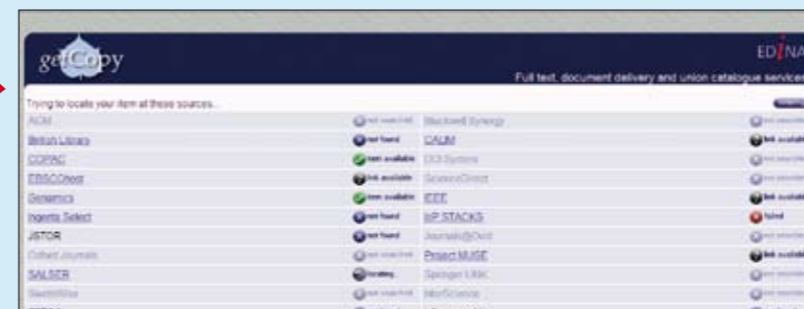
