ACCESS TO THE **BRILL JOURNAL ARCHIVE ONLINE** INCLUDED IN (INSTITUTIONAL) SUBSCRIPTIONS

The *Brill Journal Archive Online* gives access to over 50,000 articles, published before the year 2000. Some of the journals started publication over a hundred years ago. The content of virtually all of Brill's older journal backfiles has become available online in early 2008.

Libraries will automatically have full access to the archival content of journals currently subscribed to, and will continue to have access to archival content for as long as active subscriptions are maintained. Libraries and consortia wishing to acquire the archives in perpetuity are able to purchase either subject packages or the entire collection of available archives.

Access to the *Brill Journal Archive Online* will be of great benefit to the academic community, enabling scholars to search a far broader range of content and to explore historical perspectives on their area of study and research. The Brill journal archive is hosted on Brill's online journals platform at *Ingenta*.
