

The Brill Journal Archive Online Continues to Grow

THE BRILL JOURNAL ARCHIVE ONLINE

Brill is pleased to announce that the content of its journal back files is available online, going back to volume 1, issue 1 of each journal: the Brill Journal Archive Online.

The Brill Journal Archive Online offers access to almost 50,000 articles published before the year 2000, covering 6,000 issues of now 89 journals. The archive includes access to one of the world's oldest academic journals on Chinese studies, *T'oung Pao* (since 1890) and leading Brill journals such as *Behaviour* (since 1948), *Mnemosyne* (since 1948) and *Vetus Testamentum* (since 1951).

In 2009 Brill will be publishing six new journals, which were previously published elsewhere, adding **another 179 volumes** to the archive!

The academic community will find the Brill Journal Archive Online an invaluable resource for acquiring an historical perspective on the humanities, social sciences, international law & human rights, biology and materials science.

The Brill Journal Archive Online offers the same search features already familiar to users of Brill current journal content, such as full text search, navigation tools etc.

Libraries will automatically have full access to the archival content of all the journals they currently subscribe to, and will continue to have access to archival content for as long as active subscriptions are maintained.

Access to the archival content ceases upon cancellation of a subscription, but institutional customers can purchase the whole archival collection or subject-specific archive collections, to ensure perpetual access.

The Brill Journal Archive Online is exclusively hosted on IngentaConnect.

CONTENT

Archival Content

The Brill Journal Archive Online comprises **archival content** of all the journals currently in Brill's collection. This includes almost 6,000 issues and over 50,000 articles. The archival content starts with volume 1 issue 1 and goes up to the last issue published in the year 1999. It includes journals which were previously published under different names and/or by another publisher.

We started to make the archival content available in 2007; the full archive will be available by the end of 2008. New content is made available to subscribers as soon as it is released.

Current Content

To make a clear distinction between "archival content" and "current content", all Brill journal content published since the beginning of 2000 is classified as **current content**.

FEATURES

The Brill Journal Archive Online is hosted on IngentaConnect and offers all the features our users have grown accustomed to: full text search, extensive linking and other navigation tools, full text

PDF downloads, and saving and printing facilities. IngentaConnect is a CROSSREF member and ATHENS and COUNTER compliant.

ACCESS RIGHTS

Libraries have automatic access to the archival content of all journals currently subscribed to, and will continue to have access to archival content for as long as subscriptions are maintained. Libraries who have already activated online access to their Brill journals need take no further action; the archival content will be made available to them automatically, together with the current content.

Cancellations

Should a library decide to discontinue its subscription to a Brill journal, access to the archival content of that particular journal will be disabled. In line with Brill's archival policy for current content, access to all subscribed volumes published since 2000 continues for a further three (3) years after cancellation.

PURCHASE OPTIONS

Although access to subscribed journals is included in the subscription price, institutional customers may wish to consider purchasing the whole collection or subject-specific collections. The purchase option guarantees perpetual access to the Brill Journal Archive Online. Brill has a long-term archival agreement with the Royal Dutch Library (KB) in The Hague, the Netherlands. Additionally, a purchase of the archive enables libraries to save shelf space and to provide their users with the online archives of journals currently not subscribed to.
