



Editorial procedure

Articles submitted to the *Journal of the History of International Law* / *Revue d'histoire du droit international* should be original contributions and should not be under consideration for publication in any other journal or edited collection.

Only finalized and carefully proof-read work will be considered for publication.

If an author wishes to have an essay previously published in a foreign language considered by the Journal for first publication in English translation, he or she should so state at the time of submission and provide relevant copyright approval by that publication to the Journal.

Authors receive an e-offprint and a copy of the issue in which their article is published. Book reviewers receive a copy of the relevant issue.

Submission of manuscripts

Manuscript length: For a thematic book review, the Journal accepts manuscripts of no more than 10 pages, double spaced. A policy essay should be limited to a maximum of 20 pages. Scholarly research manuscripts should be no more than 40 pages.

All notes and references must be incorporated into endnotes.

Each manuscript should be submitted double-spaced with ample margins. Authors should retain a copy of the manuscript.

All pages should be numbered consecutively.

Send a virus-free disk, with manuscript formatted in Microsoft Word or WordPerfect, IBM (Windows 6.1 or later) or Mac compatible. Disks should be labelled with the name of the author.

Authors should provide brief biographical data, including current institutional affiliation, and addresses and telephone numbers where they can be reached.

Style guidelines

Authors whose first language is not English should ensure that a draft of their article has been read and corrected by a competent person whose language is English.

Short sentences, short paragraphs, simple, clear phraseology and direct tenses are distinct virtues.

Quotations should be in double quotation marks, single quotes within double. Long quotations of five or more lines should be indented.

Notes

Notes should be numbered consecutively through the text of an article with a superscript numeral corresponding to a list placed at the end. In this list the number need not be superscript, and should not be followed by a full point or a bracket.

(a) Books: All titles of books should be italicized. Give author, title, place of publication, publisher, year and page reference.

e.g., Francis Fukuyama, *The End of History and the Last Man* (New York: The Free Press, 1992), p. 44.

(b) Articles: Place titles of articles within single quotation marks. Italicize the title of the book or journal in which the article appears. Cite journal title, volume, issue number and part, year of publication and page extent of the article.

e.g., Richard J. Bloomfield, 'Making the Western hemisphere safe for democracy? The OAS defense-of-democracy regime', *The Washington Quarterly*, Vol. 17, No. 2 (Spring 1994), pp. 157-169.

Books for review

Newly published books may be sent to the editorial address above for consideration for review in the Journal.

Consent to publish

Transfer of copyright

By submitting a manuscript, the author agrees that the copyright for the article is transferred to the publisher if and when the article is accepted for publication. For that purpose the author needs to sign the **Consent to Publish** which will be sent with the first proofs of the manuscript.



Open Access

In case the author wishes to publish the article in **Open Access** he/she can choose the **Brill Open** option, which allows for a non-exclusive Open Access publication in exchange for an Article Publishing Fee, and sign a special **Brill Open Consent to Publish**.
