TEMPO (*The Early Modern Pamphlets Online*)

The Early Modern Pamphlets Online (TEMPO) offers access to pamphlets from the early modern period. *TEMPO* is a powerful online database currently (Fall 2007) containing more than 46,000 pamphlets. Around 37,000 of these titles have already been digitized and can be viewed on screen in facsimile form, offering access to over 1,000,000 pages (500,000 images).

Pamphlets constitute an indispensable primary source for historians, theologians, folklorists and art historians, as well as scholars in the fields of linguistics and literature. They reflect not only the political and social conflicts of the time, but also the struggle over religion and the church. Woodcuts, used as visual propaganda to illustrate pamphlets, provide an important resource for art historians.

The pamphlets in *TEMPO* are predominantly in Dutch, German, and Latin but *TEMPO* also includes pamphlets in French, English, and a few other languages. *TEMPO* is a growing resource; new pamphlet collections covering a variety of countries, topics, and languages are being added on a regular basis.

TEMPO CURRENTLY CONTAINS THE FOLLOWING SERIES

Dutch Pamphlets (*online catalog + facsimiles*)

- *the Knuttel collection*

Around 34,000 pamphlets (1486-1853) from the National Library of the Netherlands

- *the Van Alphen collection*

Around 2,800 pamphlets (1542-1853) from the library of the University of Groningen; none of the Van Alphen pamphlets are included in the Knuttel collection.
